

Kessel Peace Institute is named for Dr. Abbas Kessel, a 19 year Mankato Political Science Professor, born in Iran, who was an advocate of nonviolence and reason. He is remembered in Mankato for (amongst other things) almost single-handedly defusing a potentially violent demonstration against the Vietnam War in 1970. The Kessel Peace Institute offers lectures and events and is managed by Dr. Jameel Haque who is a history professor at Minnesota State University Mankato.
